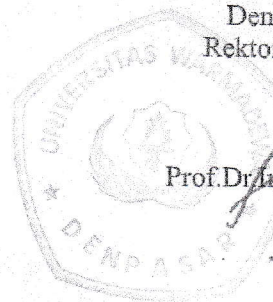

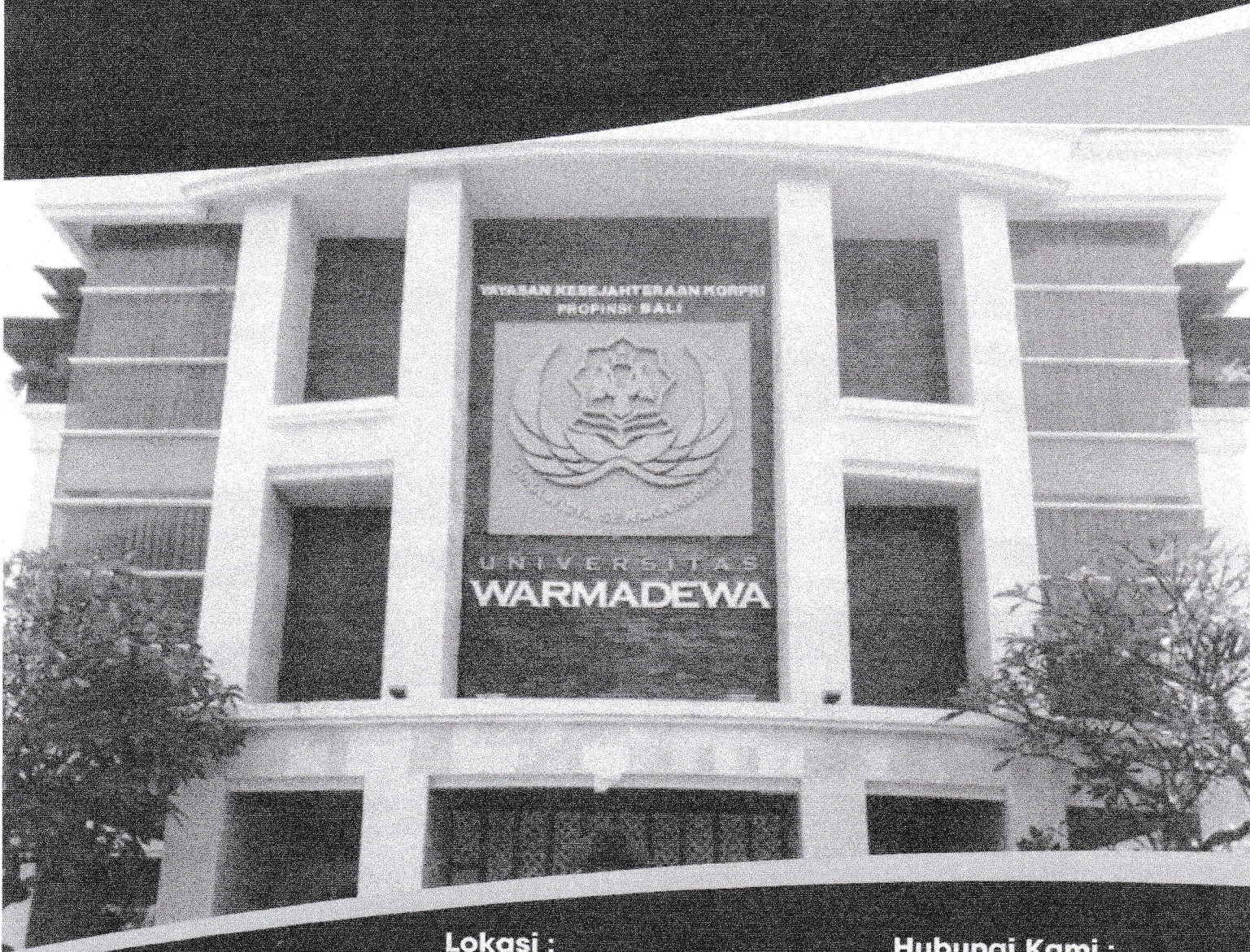

PROPOSAL FOR LECTURE AND STUDENT MOBILITY ACTIVITIES STUDENT OF THE ACCOUNTING STUDY PROGRAM, WARMADDEWA UNIVERSITY TO THE FACULTY OF ACCOUNTING, UiTM MALAYSIA

1. Introduction

In the face of the challenges of globalization and rapid technological development, graduates of higher education in the field of accounting must have competencies that are not only in accordance with national standards, but also able to compete at the international level. One of the strategic steps to equip students with global insight is through a student exchange program or student mobility.

This program provides opportunities for students to study accounting practices in other countries, delve into the implementation of technology in accounting, and understand international standards and regulations. In addition, the cross-cultural experience gained during the program will also build students' soft skills such as communication, adaptation, and collaboration.

As an educational institution committed to internationalization, Warmadewa University collaborates with the Faculty of Accountancy, Universiti Teknologi MARA (UiTM) Malaysia to organize *student mobility activities*. This activity is designed to provide a learning experience relevant to the needs of the modern accounting industry, strengthen international networks, and improve the quality of Warmadewa University graduates.

2. Activity Objectives

1. Improving students' understanding of international accounting practices.
2. Provides hands-on experience of the academic and professional environment in Malaysia.
3. Introducing students to digital transformation in the world of accounting at the ASEAN level.
4. Building a collaborative network between Warmadewa University and UiTM Malaysia.
5. Broaden students' horizons about the academic and social culture in Malaysia.

3. Activity Objectives and Achievement of KPIs

The participants of this activity were 6 students of the Accounting Study Program, Warmadewa University, accompanied by 4 accompanying lecturers.

4. Time and Place

- Activity Duration: 5 days (Day 1 & 5: Arrival and return, Day 2-4: Activities at UiTM campus.)
- Location: Faculty of Accounting, Universiti Teknologi MARA (UiTM), Malaysia.
- Implementation Period: (adjusted, e.g. January 2025).

5. Series of Activities

Day 1: Arrival- Arrival in Malaysia and transfer to accommodation.- Initial orientation and briefing by the accompanying lecturer.

Day 2: Academic Day 1 – Lecture and Workshop

Day 3: Academic Day 2 – Seminar and Panel Discussion

Day 4: Campus Tour and Closing

- Guided campus tour to introduce UiTM educational facilities.- Cultural session:

Introduction to UiTM students' traditions and activities.-

Closing and handing over certificates of participation.

Day 5: Home- Travel back to Indonesia.

6. Activity Output

1. Students understand accounting practices at the international level and the relevance of digital technology.
2. Certificate of participation from the Faculty of Accountancy UiTM.
3. Report on the results of activities from program participants.
4. Strengthening academic relations between Warmadewa University and UiTM.

7. Cost Budget

The budget will include:

1. Transportation: Flight tickets from PP Denpasar-Malaysia.
2. Accommodation: Lodging for 5 days.
3. Consumption: Eat 3 meals a day.
4. Local transportation: Travel costs in Malaysia.
5. Activity administration: Documentation, certificate making, and other logistical needs.
